OBJECTIVE: - To extend a helping hand towards the less advantaged sections of the society and make an effort to bridge the gap between the have-lots and have-nots. To sensitize the students about their social responsibilities and cultivate in them empathy, sympathy and care for the downtrodden and deprived sections of the society and make them able agents of societal transformation.

CONTEXT: - The College is aware of its duties towards the society and is a cauldron of churning out socially responsible youth who foray into the real world tackling the problems inflicting human society. As the world experiences widespread economic development, the gulf between the rich and poor has also broadened creating inequality in the society. Community centric activities like these enhance the inter-personal skills of the students. The institute aims at promoting and facilitating an overall development of students' personality where they get ample opportunities to apply their learning practically. Such activities promote the quality of selfless service and commitment towards mankind.

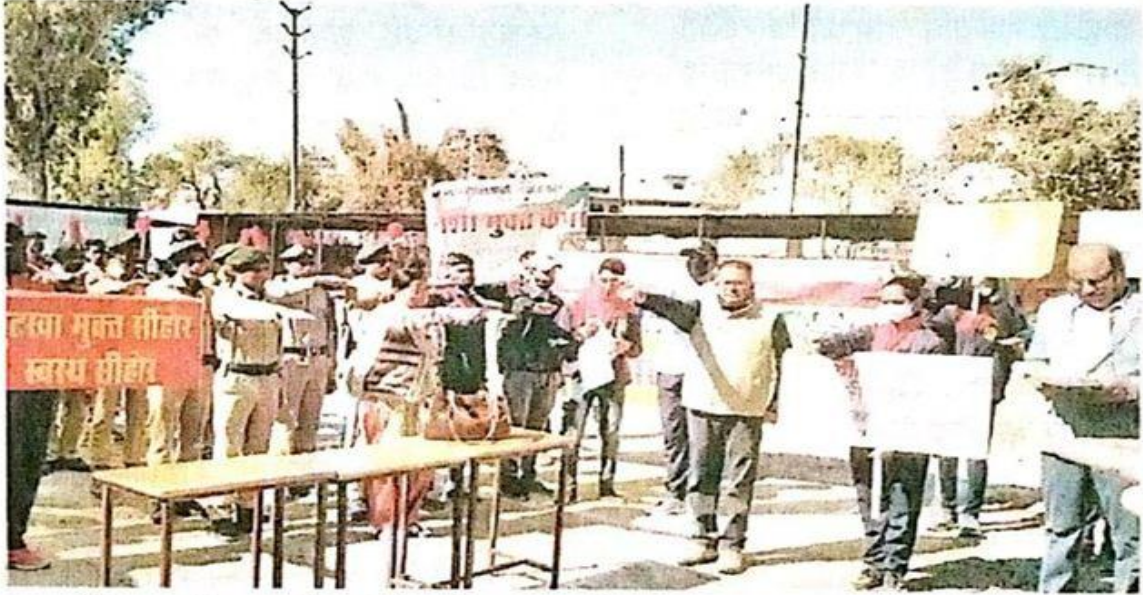
वैक्सीनेशन के समय लगाएं मास्क

Title of the practice: CLEANLINESS IS NEXT TO GODLINESS

“Cleanliness is the first law of health”

OBJECTIVE: - The college is aware of its role and responsibility in taking measures to prepare students to have an all-round personality. In the same pursuit, the College aims at cultivating the habit of cleanliness in the students through various activities carried out throughout the year. The college believes in taking forward the national call for ‘Swachhata’ in all its aspects. The college shoulders the responsibility of spreading awareness on this matter among the students and locals of Sehore district. As many students of the college hail from small villages, they have lesser cognizance of the need of personal and social hygiene. It is here that the college steps in and sheds light on the importance of cleanliness.

CONTEXT: - Cleanliness is an indispensable part of the civilized individual’s life. The students are made to adopt cleanliness as a way of life through various activities and programs that are organized throughout the year. As one of the fundamental duties enshrined in the Constitution exhorts the citizens to preserve our natural environment, the college aims at instilling this sense of duty in the students. It is important that students are taught to perform their duties in addition to enjoying their rights. Cleanliness campaigns and drives that the students participate in makes the students develop an attitude of caring for their surroundings- lakes, wildlife, rivers, forests, etc. The purpose is to educate the students so that they can also sensitize others around them.

THE PRACTICE: - The students participate in various cleanliness drives all the year round where they clean the local areas, river banks and other historical sites in the city. Moreover, the students and staff regularly participate in cleaning the college campus- classrooms, playground, etc. Green and blue color dustbins are placed at various corners in the campus so as to easily segregate bio-degradable and non-biodegradable waste. Some activities that focus on recycling the discarded materials- ‘Best out of Waste’ are conducted in order to make the students inculcate environmentally sustainable practices. The students and staff take an ‘Oath of Cleanliness’ every year.

- Godgram Scheme- The NSS unit adopts nearby villages under the Godgram Scheme through which the local village communities are made aware of the importance of adopting cleanliness practices.
- The ancient monuments and sites are frequented by visitors who litter the premises. Our students participate in cleanliness drives at such places and also raise awareness on protecting these sites.
- Organizing meditation and yoga sessions for enhancing the purity of the minds.
- Organizing various competitions like- **poster making, essay writing, rangoli making, etc.**
- Charting out a design/plan of programs to be organized throughout the year.

- Constituting an Eco Club focusing on environment cleanliness.
- Taking the pledge for cleanliness.
- Cleaning the college campus- The faculty and students register an active participation in cleaning the college campus.
- Spreading the message of cleanliness in the streets of the city through nukkad natak (street play).
- Organizing rallies to raise awareness on cleanliness.
- Cleaning of the local water body- Siwan river. This river is the lifeline of Sehore's economy and regular cleaning of its banks is important. Our students and faculty perform the cleaning activity.

EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS: - It is a success of the practice that the students have developed a sense of both personal and public cleanliness. They have realized the importance of maintaining and promoting cleanliness in their immediate surroundings. They have started working towards promoting health and hygiene in the lives of people around them. Because of the regular cleaning drives organized at the college with an aim to clean the class rooms and college campus, the staff and students have developed a sense of duty. As cleanliness has become a way of life, the college family is keen at keeping the campus spick and span at all times. The waste is well segregated in separate dustbins for biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste.

PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED: - As the smooth running of every activity is mired with hindrances, so is this cleanliness campaign. Cleaning of the campus and the villages in the vicinity requires cleaning apparatus- mops, broom sticks, gloves, dustpans, phenyl, etc., which sometimes are difficult to arrange and distribute. It is also difficult to arrange funds for the running of the program.
